



Prove one decision from signal to outcome

Evaluate SOAR on the quality and accountability of a real decision, not on demonstration polish.

The evaluation question

Can a second reviewer follow the same evidence, understand the alternatives and reach a defensible management decision without replaying the demonstration?

01 Choose one consequential decision

Select a real service, an approved evidence window and a question with a named operational owner.

02 Record today's baseline

Capture the current time, handoffs, corrections and effort required to reach the same decision.

03 Run and challenge

Include an ambiguous case, stale evidence and a failed dependency. Ask an independent reviewer to reproduce the reasoning.

04 Decide with evidence

Compare clarity, reproducibility, operating effort, operational safeguards and unresolved gaps; record expand, narrow, pause or stop.

Evidence of value

Faster shared understanding, fewer hidden assumptions, a clearer owner handoff and a decision another reviewer can explain.

Evidence of control

Visible source and time basis, labelled simulations, explicit authority, recovery conditions and fresh verification where execution is in scope.

A successful evaluation ends with an adoption decision and an owner for every unresolved prerequisite.
